

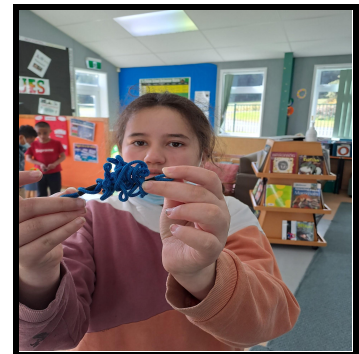


9 September 2022 (Week 5, Term 3; 2022)
