Academic Achievement:

The Rumaki unit maintains strong Te Reo Māori proficiency, with students meeting standards in pānui, tuhituhi, and kōrero. Numeracy and literacy show steady progress across all pathways, with support for those needing extra help. Both Tuakana and Mainstream Senior students are involved in sports, as well as learning haka to perform at sports Tournaments.

Student Wellbeing & Attendance:

Engagement remains high, supported by pastoral care and whānau hui. A Term 1 survey showed 85% feel safe. Attendance is 88%, with Rumaki at 91% and mainstream at 86%. Targeted interventions address absenteeism.

Staff & Professional Development:

Staff adapt Term 1 PD workshops were completed.

Complaints Procedures

The school's complaints procedure for parents ensures concerns are first addressed with the kaiako. If unresolved, they should be escalated in writing to the Tumuaki, and further issues may be taken to the Board. All complaints are managed in accordance with School Docs - see last page



Health & Safety:

Fire and earthquake drills are planned for Term 2. Minor first-aid incidents are well-managed. Hygiene awareness and healthy eating programs are reinforced. An emergency response plan review is scheduled.

Building & Grounds:

Classrooms and admin areas are routinely cleaned. Grounds are well-maintained, with Probation Services assisting in upkeep.

Governance & Leadership:

Whānau engagement through newsletters and hui is strong. Strategic planning aligns with the school's vision. Leadership initiatives empower senior students.

Board Representative:

The Education Review Office (E.R.O) has requested a representative for Te Rumaki Reo Māori to serve on the Board of Trustees.
